

Mass Deploying STOPzilla Office Edition through Group Policy

REQUIREMENTS:

- Target computers must be part of a domain.
- Must have a file sharing server and an Active Domain server.

SET UP:

1. Create a distribution point. Log onto your file sharing server and create a shared network folder where you will put the installation file. Set permissions on the share to allow access to the distribution package (Share and NTFS Permissions READ & WRITE).
2. Log into your Active Directory server and launch **Active Directory Users and Computers**. Make sure that the target PCs are part of the same group or organizational unit.
3. Open Group Policy Management, you can use the **RUN** tool and type gpmc.msc to start the application.
4. Locate the group or organizational unit in the tree where you have placed the target PCs, right click it and left click on **Create a GPO in this domain and Link it here...** Then name your new policy as you see fit and click ok.
5. Double-click the newly created policy to edit it. Right click the link listed under **Links** and left click "Enforce".
6. Right-click the newly created policy now listed in the forest tree on the left, then left-click edit.
7. Under **Computer Configuration**, expand **Policies** then expand **Software Settings**. Click on Software installations to list the current installation policies for this group.
8. Right click the empty list, hover over **New** and left click **Package...**
9. Locate the shared file that was created during step 1 and select it. (This file must be in a shared network location in order for the scope client computers to be able to access it)
10. Select **Assigned** deployment method and click OK.
11. The next time the PC is powered on, and ANY user logs in, the software will automatically install.
